KNLTB Head Coach Men's Padel

The Head Coach Men's Padel is part of the Technical Staff Padel and works closely with three to four colleagues. You will be jointly responsible for the further development of Dutch high performance padel and you will report to our Technical Director.

What are your responsibilities?

You will be responsible for the training and competition schedules of the top men in padel by

- Developing and creating programs for the players of men's selection
- Providing weekly training sessions for group C (under 23-years of age) three times a week (at Sportclub Houten)
- Providing additional training sessions before a big team event
- Meeting weekly with multi-disciplinary team
- Meeting weekly with office staff to monitor the year planning including theme sessions that are part of the individual PDP's
- Visiting player training sessions in their private environment for good cooperation with personal coaches
- Conducting progress interviews with the players
- Visiting tournaments and supervising exchanges and (international) tournaments (approximately 10 international travel weeks per year)
- Providing input for any schedule improvements and implementing them
- Consulting with the Head Coach Juniors at a regular basis to discuss the development and intake of upcoming junior talents
- Deciding on the selection for the Dutch team for team events, such as European Championships and World Championships.
- Keeping Smartabase (human performance optimization platform) up to date when used by the players
- Discussing and improving on physical programs in consultation with the physical trainer of the players (if any)
- Being the team captain when this is needed during World Cups, European Championships or European Olympic Games.
- You are the face and the example for the sport and KNLTB

The requirements for the job are that you

- · Are able to work and think at a higher professional education level
- Possess good organizational skills
- Possess a valid padel coach A license



- Preferably have extensive knowledge and (proven) experience in the field of international performance padel
- Have coaching experience at a national and preferably also international level
- Have optimal coaching skills in complex circumstances
- Have leadership qualities that are personal and connecting
- Possess professional seniority and natural authority and you are able to act impartial
- Demonstrate affinity with men's padel
- Are result-oriented
- Are able to coach at or attend tournaments abroad for approximately 10 weeks a year
- Can motivate and stimulate players
- Have very good communication skills
- Have good computer skills including Word, Excel, Outlook and Powerpoint
- Have good command of the English and preferably the Dutch language
- Are flexible in your agenda to attend appointments and meetings (organized by the KNLTB)
